## **Academic**

The academic performance of the students during the year has been exemplary. The school achieved excellent results in the board examinations in 2026, reflecting the hard work, dedication, and consistent efforts of both the students and the teachers. A result with 100% pass rate and a top score of 96.8% and 21 out of 36 students scored distinction.

Students of Grades 4 to 6 had an exciting trip to Fun World, while students of Grades 7 and 8 visited to Hebbal Science Museum to enhance their scientific knowledge.

For the first time, the students of Grades 9 and 10 travelled outstation to Thiruvananthapuram to witness a rocket launch at the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre, making it a memorable and inspiring experience.

Robotics combines science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. This programme allows students to apply classroom theories practically. Conducted as an after-school activity, the sessions aim to ignite creativity, innovation, and problem-solving skills across grades. In the first session, lower-grade students created an SPST car, operating without a remote control. Senior students worked on DPDT cars, controlling



movement and direction. These projects demonstrate real-life science applications. This initiative goes beyond teaching theories; it equips students with skills to adapt and thrive in a rapidly changing world. By nurturing curiosity and creativity, Mother Teresa Public School guides learners towards building a future, or perhaps even a new world of their own.
